### Housing Fees\* (in UAE Dirhams)

Room Fee	7,000 to 15,000 per semester + 5% VAT* <small>* New first-time students joining in Fall 2024 will receive a 25 percent discount. **First-time students to AUS dormitories are also eligible for a discount, based on their academic year of intake.</small>
Utilities Service Fee	290 per semester+ 5% VAT
Residential Halls Maintenance Deposit	1,000
Room Reservation Fee (required for new applicants)	1,000



## Applying to AUS

Admission to AUS is competitive and the actual required minimum average will depend on a number of factors, including your average secondary education scores, ACT, EmsAT or SAT (as applicable), the number of qualified applicants, the number of available seats and your English proficiency testing scores.

The minimum required average for accepting an application for consideration is the equivalent of 80 percent or more in the final year of secondary school (depending on the education system), or 80 percent or more in the best two out of the last three years. Higher averages may be applicable for certain colleges and/or majors. Other program-specific requirements may also apply.
