DEPOSIT AND PAYMENT INFORMATION

In order to secure your seat and confirm your enrollment at St. George's University, you must submit a deposit along with your signed Acknowledgment of Admission. This deposit will be applied toward your tuition and is non-refundable. Deposit amounts vary across programs, and due dates for each payment vary based on date of acceptance. After you submit your deposit, you can check your Student Self-Service Account for your payment balance.

Tuition is billed each term.

All deposit payments can be made by check, money order, bank wire, or as a commercial deposit within any Bank of America branch. After the initial deposit, you may pay via credit card, or if you have a US checking or savings bank account you can make an Automated Clearing House (ACH) payment using your Student Self-Service Account.

Once you have paid your deposit and received instructions to access your Student Self-Service Account, you will be able to view your official bill and financial aid status.

- Student using a US bank account will also have the ability to pay their remaining balance through Student Self-Service.
- All other students will need to use the payment methods above to settle their account.

ADDITIONAL ESTIMATED ANNUAL LIVING EXPENSES
